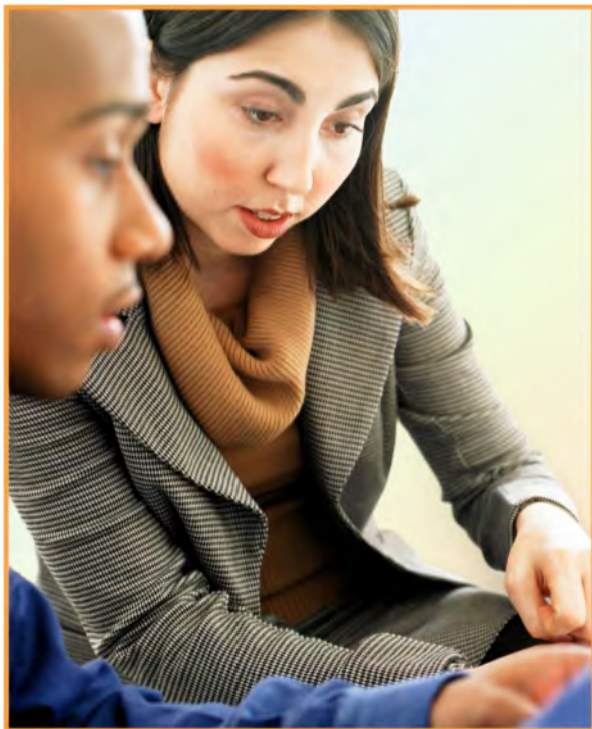
Needs Assessment
