- Identifies relevant Title 24, Part 6 compliance documents based on input of addition/ alteration project scope information
- Provides checklist to guide the user through the submission of required compliance documentation
- Identifies if project requires HERS forms to be submitted, indicating a HERS Rater is necessary



- Presentation package for building departments including all materials needed to conduct quarterly industry workshops
- Intended primarily to be presented by building departments to their local industry
- Other organizations, such as the CEC, could give workshops in localities where building departments are not able to do so



- Residential and nonresidential field guides to assist in identifying proper installation techniques and visual aides for some components commonly installed incorrectly
- Designed for Building Inspector and HERS Rater hard-copy use on-site
- Provides visuals of proper installation through photographs
- Field guide sheets can also be distributed by building department with building permits
